On **November 9<sup>TH</sup>, 2009** an amazing event occurred in Tallahassee at Hillel at FSU. A community came together to celebrate. It was the inauguration of “Recipe For Life - the Kristallnacht Memorial dinner program, honoring survivors of the Holocaust and their zest for life.

The event brought together the Tallahassee community of all ages and backgrounds: FSU students, Jewish community members, survivors and those who had lost family during the Holocaust. We remembered the Holocaust and honored the survivors by serving a full-course dinner, prepared by Hillel staff and students. Recipes came directly from the *Holocaust Survivors Cookbook*. Tears were shed and then, many smiles finally appeared, as student leaders shared the stories behind the recipes. One survivor and several children of survivors from our own community shared their stories, as well.

Last year, many guests asked if the program would be continued. Members of the community called, after they heard of the dinner, and asked if they could already reserve a seat for next year. Last year we had seating for 70 and half of those seats went to students.

On **Tuesday, November 9<sup>TH</sup>, 2010** we will hold the second annual “Recipe For Life Kristallnacht Memorial Dinner.” This year we anticipate the event growing. We hope to accommodate the interest. We ask the broader Jewish community, wherever you live, to do a great mitzvah and support this very special evening.

This year dinner will be prepared with help of Next Generation (DOR v DOR). This new group of FSU women is part of a innovative program with Hillel and the Holocaust Education Resource Council (HERC). The newly re-inspired Hadassah-Tallahassee chapter will also work with Next Generation students to coordinate this wonderful dinner. Survivors and children of survivors living in Tallahassee join us for the dinner. This year we will be able accommodate 120 guests, on a still first-come, first-served.
